What are the monetary commitments for show choir?

- Families are responsible for paying show choir fees, voice lesson costs (including accompanist fees for recitals and festivals), contributing to concession donations for Lone Star Show Choir Invitational, summer boot camp fees, and any trip cost for an out-of-state competition.
- **UPDATED:** VOC will have a show choir fee of \$500 for the **2025–2026** school year, while Voltage will remain at a \$400 fee. Both include the **\$100 audition fee/deposit** as a part of the total cost and not in addition to.

Should my student be in voice lessons?

- YES! ALL show choir students are required to be in private voice lessons
 throughout the entire school year. We have amazing voice teachers at Central
 that show choir kids can study with—or they can study privately outside of school
 and communicate with us who their teacher is and what they do.
- Voice lessons in Keller ISD cost \$24 per lesson, and students take lessons once a week. Scholarships are available by application in the fall. Each student MUST perform at their studio recitals and solo contest to maintain show choir compliance!

Is there an out-of-state competition trip this year?

• **TBD.** We hope to have more information to share about who will and where we will travel at our **May "You Made It!" Meeting**. There will be approximately a \$1,000 monetary commitment for this trip.

What does the rehearsal schedule look like?

- VOC rehearses every week on Tuesdays and Fridays from 6:00–7:45 AM and twice a month on Mondays from 6:30–8:30 PM.
- Voltage meets as a class period during the school day and has additional outside-of-school rehearsals as needed in the fall and 6:00-7:45 AM once a week during competition season in the spring, with the potential for evening rehearsals. Families will be notified at least 2 weeks in advance.
